Performance Description

Urza and The Song in the Dark is a brand-new children's fable set in a subterranean wonderland of complex caves, underground lakes and fantastical creatures. A mysterious song leads a young girl named Urza on an adventure to find her way back to the surface. Along the way she befriends a lost explorer, gets pursued by a mysterious, dark force and finds herself caught up in a primeval story of mythical proportions.

Devised for children and kiddults aged 7+, using puppetry, live songs, original music and stunningly layered, shadow visuals; Urza is a unique work for young audiences.

The show runs for 60 minutes.

Space Requirements

Lighting

Overview:

Urza and The Song in the Dark is designed to flexibly fit into any space with lighting for the show primarily derived from 3 overhead projectors and headlamps. We will provide a small rig (as specified below). These are all ground lights and don't require a full rig. In equipped venues Matriark can provide a lighting design that makes use of this.

If Lighting Rig is available then LX pre-rig will be required. Venue specific lighting plans will be available 1 month prior.

Full LX Rig Performance Requirements

Positions	2/3x above stage lighting bars
Fixtures	TBC
Dimmers	TBC
Dimmer Distribution	TBC.
Lighting Desk	Cues input into venue console.

Presenter to provide:

- All lighting fixtures, accessories & gels as per plan
- All dimmers and cabling
- Appropriate levels of blue light backstage

No/Limited LX Rig Performance Requirements

Presenter to provide:

- 2-3 easily, accessible power points.
- Ability to darken performance space during daylight hours.

Matriark to provide:

- Overhead projectors and additional floor lighting.
- Cabling and Powerboards.
